2. There will be a free clinic prior to the tournament.
3. The top three wrestlers in each weight class in the *Cadet and Junior* divisions qualify for the National Tournament held in Fargo, ND on July 14 – 22 (More info on this will be given out at the Tournament.)
4. All wrestlers who qualify and will be attending the National Tournament **MUST** attend the Team West Virginia training camp(s). Information on the training camps and travel to Fargo will be given out at the tournament. (Note: The training camp(s) are open to ANY Cadet and Junior wrestler in West Virginia – even if you are not going to Fargo! More info on this will be available at the tournament)
